



2010 Air Transport Pilot Licence Theory Scholarship Sponsored by Air BP

The Australian Women Pilots' Association, in conjunction with Air BP, are pleased to announce the availability of a scholarship, to be awarded on a \$ for \$ basis to assist a female pilot to complete an Air Transport Pilot Licence Theory Course.

The scholarship will be announced during the Presentation dinner at the AWPA Annual Conference in March, 2010 at Ballarat in Victoria.

Minimum Requirements

1. Applicants for the scholarship must have a minimum of 300 hours total time.
2. Applicants must have a current Commercial Pilots Licence.
3. Applicants must have a pass in the CASA IREX theory exam.

Applications

- All applications shall be on the attached application form, with additional information attached as required.
- All applications shall be addressed to ATPL Theory Scholarship, AWPA Vice President, PO Box 1022 Mudgee, NSW 2850.
- All applications shall be post marked no later than the 31st of January 2010.
- Please provide the original application plus 3 photocopies of all pages.

Applications must include the following items:

- A copy of the last 2 pages of your pilots log book.
- A copy of your IREX result
- A copy of your Commercial Pilots Licence/Medical

General Conditions

1. The scholarship is available from 20th March 2010 to 30th June 2011. It is not possible to back date the payment of funds to the scholarship winner, prior to the announcement date of 20th March 2010.
2. The Scholarships are personal to the recipient and cannot therefore be transferred to another, or cashed in, in the event of inability to continue training for any reason.
3. The Scholarship shall take the form of up to \$1,000.00 on a \$ for \$ basis to be paid to the recipient. The amount up to a possible \$1,000.00 will only be paid once the original receipts made out to the recipient are received by the AWPA Treasurer.
4. The Scholarship Organisers:
 - a) Will not extend the value of the scholarship to account for changes in costs of ATPL courses;
 - b) Decision as to the selection of the recipient is final;
 - c) Reserve the right not to present either scholarship if in the judgment of the selection panel the applicants do not meet the criteria.
