



Aviation Safety Management Course Scholarship

*(Sponsored by the Australian Government through the
Australian Transport Safety Bureau)*

The Australian Women Pilots' Association in conjunction with the Australian Government through the Australian Transport Safety Bureau, are pleased to announce the availability of one scholarship for a member of AWPAs, employed as a commercial pilot, to undertake an aviation safety management course.

The scholarship will be announced during the Presentation dinner at the AWPAs Annual Conference at Ballarat, Victoria on March 20th, 2010.

Minimum Requirements

- Applicants must be a member of AWPAs at the time of their application.
- Applicants must have a current Commercial Pilots Licence or higher.
- Applicants must be employed as a commercial pilot at the time of selection.

Applications

- All applications shall be on the attached application form, with additional information (including essay) attached as required.
- All applications shall be addressed to Aviation Safety Management Course Scholarship, AWPAs Vice President, PO Box 1022 MUDGEE, NSW 2850.
- All applications shall be post marked no later than the 31st of January 2010.
- Please provide the original application plus 3 photocopies of all pages.

Applications must include the following items:

- A copy of the last 2 pages of your pilots log book.
- A copy of your licence and aviation medical.
- Proof of employment as a commercial pilot.

General Conditions

1. Previous winners of the scholarship are not eligible.
2. The scholarship is available from March 20th, 2010 to the 30th of June 2011. It is not possible to back date the payment of funds to the scholarship winner, prior to the announcement date of March 20th, 2010.

3. The Scholarship is personal to the recipient and cannot therefore be transferred to another, or cashed in the event of inability to continue training for any reason.
4. The Scholarship shall take the form of up to \$2000.00. The money may be used for course fees, course materials and out of pocket expenses such as travel and accommodation in relation to the undertaking of an aviation safety management course. The amount (up to \$2000.00) will only be paid upon submission of
 - a. proof of the successful completion of the course or relevant unit(s) of study, and
 - b. the original receipts made out to the recipient.

All documentation should be submitted to the **AWPA National Treasurer, PO Box 90 AAC Building, Cairns International Airport Qld 4870** for reimbursement purposes.

5. The Scholarship may be used to cover the costs of safety or human factors subjects in an aviation degree or course of study.
6. The Scholarship Organisers:
 - a) Will not extend the value of the scholarship to account for changes in costs of aviation management courses;
 - b) Decision as to the selection of the recipient is final;
 - c) Reserve the right not to present the scholarship if in the judgment of the selection panel the applicants do not meet the criteria.
