Element 3: Describe your present goals, your goals five years from now, your ultimate goal and how you anticipate achieving each of them?

Element 4: How will this scholarship help you reach your goals? Why do you think you deserve this scholarship?

Please note the two categories of applicants and ensure your application takes these into account and provides the required documentation.
