The Australian Women Pilots' Association Basic Aerobatics Rating Scholarship

The Australian Women Pilots' Association are pleased to announce the availability of a scholarship to be awarded **to the value of \$1000 on a \$ for \$ basis** to complete a Basic Aerobatics Rating.

The scholarship will be announced during the Presentation dinner at the AWPA Annual Conference at Ballarat, Victoria, on 20th March, 2010.

Minimum Requirements

1. Applicants for the scholarship must have a minimum of 150 hours total time.
2. Applicants must have a current Private Pilots Licence.

Applications

- All applications shall be on the 2010 Application Form, with additional information attached as required.

- All applications shall be post marked no later than the 31st of January 2010 – **Email or Faxed applications will not be accepted.**
- Please provide the original application plus **3 photocopies** of all pages.

Applications must include the following items:

- A copy of the last 2 pages of your pilots log book.
- A copy of your Private Pilots Licence/Medical

General Conditions

1. The scholarship is available for the period from 20th March 2010 to 30th of June 2011 – no backdating of payments prior to announcements will be undertaken for the successful recipient.
2. The scholarships are personal to the recipient and cannot therefore be transferred to another, or cashed in the event of inability to continue training for any reason.
3. The Scholarship shall take the form of up to \$1000.00 on a \$ for \$ basis to be paid to the training organisation. The amount will only be paid once an account from the training organisation in the recipients name is received by the AWPA National Treasurer, P O Box 90 AAC Building, Cairns International Airport Qld 4870
4. The Scholarship Organisers:
 - a) will not extend the value of the scholarship to account for changes in costs of Basic Aerobatics courses,
 - b) Decision as to the selection of the recipient is final,
 - c) Reserve the right not to present either scholarship if in the judgment of the selection panel the applicants do not meet the criteria.
