The Australian Women Pilots' Association in conjunction with Airservices Publications are pleased to announce the availability of **two Student Pilot** scholarships. Each scholarship consists of provision of the geographically relevant charts and documents (to the value of \$550 inclusive of GST) for a Student Pilot to facilitate the navigation phase of their Private Pilot Licence Training.

The awards are provisionally to be one female and one male, however they will be awarded to the most worthy applicants regardless of gender.

The scholarship will be announced during the Presentation dinner at the AWPAs Annual Conference in Ballarat, Victoria, on the 20th March, 2010.

Minimum Requirements

1. Applicants for the scholarship must have a minimum of 10 hours total time.
2. Applicants must have a pass in the Basic Aeronautical Knowledge (BAK) theory exam.

Applications must include the following items:

- A copy of the last 2 pages of your pilot log book.
- A copy of your **Student** Pilot Licence
- Photograph of yourself that could be used for promotional purposes by Airservices Australia

General Conditions

- The awards will available for 12 months from the date it is announced.
- The awards are personal to the recipient and cannot therefore be transferred to another, or cashed in the event of inability to continue training for any reason.
- The Scholarship shall take the form of the following documents and charts:
