



## ***AWPA RA Aus Endorsements Scholarship***

### ***Entry Details:***

- This scholarship is intended to assist an RA Aus pilot to attain either of these steps:-
  - RA Aus Cross-country Endorsement
  - RA Aus Instructor Rating
- To apply for the award you must complete the application form, and tell us (in up to 500 words) how obtaining the specified endorsement will benefit you.
- Note. If you wish to apply in both these categories, please send two separate applications, clearly marked as to which Endorsement/Rating this application and essay supports.
- This award is open to all women who are permanent Australian residents, and who hold an RA Aus Pilot Certificate, and who have either not yet commenced training for the planned endorsement, or have not yet completed that training.
- Besides an RA Aus Pilot Certificate, you must already hold any other necessary pre-requisites for the training you wish to undertake.
- If there is a theory exam involved, you must also have completed that theory examination by the application closing date of 31 January (evidence to be provided).
- Membership of AWPA is not required at the time of application, however if you are successful you will be required to join AWPA.
- The applications will be judged by judges primarily from RA Aus backgrounds.
- The intention is to encourage women going through the RA Aus stream of training, thus holding GA qualifications already will be no particular advantage.
- The recipient of the award will be announced at the next AWPA conference.
- A cost estimate from the proposed flying school or organization will be required
- The money awarded will be paid to the flying school/organization of the winner's choice on a dollar for dollar basis up to \$1000. Receipts must be supplied
- Closing date for applications is 5pm 31st January 2010. (See forwarding details on page 3.)

  - a copy (or scanned copy) of the result slips for theory examinations (if applicable), and copy of signed log book page or other evidence of RA Aus Pilot Certificate
- A cost estimate from the proposed flying school or organization providing the training
