CONDITIONS

- By the closing date, each applicant must
 - have been a member of AWPA for at least 24 months of continuous membership prior to the closing date of the application,
 - as a scholarship holder, intend to retain AWPA membership for the next two years,
 - be a permanent resident of Australia, and
 - hold a current Australian Commercial Pilot's Licence.
- Each application must be submitted to the applicant's state scholarship representative by the closing date, and must include the following:
 - The original and seven (7) exact copies of the completed application form: Total 8
 - names, addresses and phone numbers of the applicant's Chief Flying Instructor and two referees (one from outside the aviation industry).
 - Include a brief summary of reasons for applying for this scholarship.
- Applicants currently training for the rating/s applied for will not necessarily be precluded, providing they comply with all the entry conditions.
- The successful candidate must
 - confirm in writing, within three months of receiving the award, an intention to accept the scholarship;
 - lodge written progress reports every three months thereafter with the scholarship co-ordinator; and
 - take up the scholarship within one year from the date of announcement (an extension of time may be granted at the Selection Panel's discretion, provided a written application reaches the Panel Co-ordinator before the expiry date).
- Scholarship funds will be paid to the flying school of the winner's choice on a dollar-for-dollar basis, on receipt of a monthly statement from the flying school.
- The selection panel's decision in awarding the scholarship will be final.
