



The Australian Women Pilots' Association PPL Charts and Documents Award 2012

The Australian Women Pilots' Association in conjunction with Airservices Publications are pleased to announce the availability of **two Student Pilot** awards. Each award consists of the provision of geographically relevant charts and documents (to the value of \$550 inclusive of GST) for a Student Pilot to facilitate the navigation phase of their Private Pilot Licence Training.

The awards are provisionally to be one female and one male, however they will be awarded to the most worthy applicants regardless of gender.

The awards will be announced during the Presentation Dinner at the AWPA Annual Conference in Bunbury, Western Australia, on the 21st April, 2012.

Minimum Requirements

1. Applicants for the scholarship must have a minimum of 10 hours total time.
2. Applicants must have a pass in the Basic Aeronautical Knowledge (BAK) theory exam.

Applications

All applications must be on the correct application form, with additional information attached as required.

Applications must include the following items:

- Copy of both sides of the last 2 pages of your open pilot's log book to show your flying experience
- Copy of the page in your logbook that records your **BAK pass**
- Copy of your **CASA Student** Pilot Licence
- Copy of your **CASA pilots medical**
- Passport-sized photograph of yourself that could be used for promotional purposes by Airservices Australia.

General Conditions

- The awards will be available for 12 months from the date of announcement.
- The awards are personal to the recipient and cannot therefore be transferred to another, or cashed in the event of inability to continue training for any reason.
- The awards shall take the form of the following documents and charts:
 - ✓ Civil Aviation Orders + (12month amend service)
 - ✓ Civil Aviation Regulations + (12 month amend service)
 - ✓ Aeronautical Information Package (AIP) Book + (12 month amend service)
 - ✓ Visual Flight Guide
 - ✓ 1 x Enroute Supplement Australia + (12month amend service)
 - ✓ 2 x World Aeronautical Charts (relevant to your area of training)
 - ✓ Australia VTC package
 - ✓ 1 x VNC chart (relevant to your area of training)
 - ✓ Australia ERC package
 - ✓ Planning Chart Australia
- The Scholarship Organisers:
 - a) Make the final decision as to the selection of the recipients of these awards
 - b) Reserve the right not to present either scholarship if in the opinion of the selection panel the applicants do not meet the criteria
 - c) Will accept only electronically submitted applications (with original documents also mailed in).
