### SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Australian Women Pilots' Association in conjunction with Aero Refuellers are pleased to announce the availability of **two RA-Aus Student Pilot** Scholarships. The scholarships are intended to provide financial assistance for RA-Aus Student Pilots who have in excess of 5 hours total time in powered aircraft, to complete their RA-Aus Pilots Certificate.

The total value of each Scholarship is up to \$1,500 on a dollar-for-dollar basis (recipient contributes the same amount to her training).

The Scholarship winners will be announced during the Presentation Dinner at the AWPA Annual Conference in Bunbury, Western Australia, on the 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2012.

#### Requirements

1. Applicants for the scholarship must have a minimum of 5 hours total time in powered aircraft.
2. Applicants must be a member of AWPA.
3. Provide a letter of recommendation from their Flying School.
4. Provide an essay in no more than 500 words that
  - explains why you want to become a pilot and where did this desire originate, and
  - describes your present goals and how this scholarship will help you to achieve those goals.

#### Applications

All applications must be on the correct application form, with additional information attached as required.

Please forward the original application and all attachments by post, **following** electronic submission in PDF format to the National Vice President.

#### Applications must include the following items:

- Your essay
- Copy of the last page of your **pilot log book** in support of your flight time
- Letter of recommendation **from your Flying School**
- Copy of your **Student** Pilot Certificate

## General Conditions

- The awards will be available for 12 months from the date of announcement of the successful applicants.
- The awards are personal to the recipient and cannot therefore be transferred to another person, or converted to cash in the event of inability to continue training for any reason.
- The Scholarship Organisers reserve the right not to present the scholarships if, in the judgment of the selection panel, none of the applicants meets the criteria.
- The decision made by the Scholarship Organisers as to the successful recipients is final and correspondence will not be entered into.
- The scholarship is available from 21<sup>st</sup> April 2012 to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2013 and is not retrospective; it is not possible to backdate the payment of funds to the scholarship winner, prior to the announcement date.
