LADY CASEY SCHOLARSHIP

Closing date: January 31st each year

The Lady Casey Scholarship, named after our first patron, is awarded to assist an AWPA member in furthering her career in aviation. The scholarship is valued at up to \$5000 paid on a dollar for dollar basis (ie 50% reimbursement of costs) toward flight training for a command instrument rating or an instructor rating.

Administration:

The scholarship is managed by a co-ordinator and a representative from each State. All are members of AWPA. The State representatives receive the applications by the closing date and form the selection panel. Scholarship funds will be paid to the flying school of the winner's choice on a dollar-for-dollar basis, or by reimbursement of 50% of costs paid. A small percentage is withheld until the rating is achieved.

Conditions:

1. By the closing date, each applicant must
 - have been a member of AWPA for at least 24 months of continuous membership prior to the closing date of the application,
 - as a scholarship holder, intend to retain AWPA membership for the next two years,
 - be a permanent resident of Australia, and
 - be qualified to exercise the privileges of an Australian Commercial Pilot's Licence.
2. Applicants currently training for the rating/s applied for will not necessarily be precluded, providing they comply with all the entry conditions.
3. The successful candidate must
 - confirm in writing, within three months of receiving the award, an intention to accept the scholarship;
 - lodge written progress reports every three months thereafter with the scholarship co-ordinator; and
 - take up the scholarship within one year from the date of announcement (an extension of time may be granted at the Selection Panel's discretion, provided a written application reaches the Panel Co-ordinator before the expiry date).
4. Failure to complete any item may result in disqualification.
5. The selection panel's decision in awarding the scholarship will be final.

How to apply.

Application forms are available from the co-ordinator, State Representatives and the AWPA website. Each application must be submitted to the applicant's State representative by the closing date and include:

- The original and seven (7) exact copies of the completed application form (8 in total)
- Name, address and contact numbers of the applicant's flying instructor,
- Names, addresses and contact numbers of two referees, one from outside the aviation industry. Do not include references as referees will be contacted if necessary.
- Short resume
- An essay of not more than 2 pages addressing, but not restricted to, your interest in aviation; your career ambitions; your aims and goals and your reasons for applying for the Lady Casey Scholarship.
